## jāti and guṇas in Professional Life (karma)

## Scriptural Flexibility and Historical Examples

- Born into a Brahmin (priestly) family
- Chose to become a warrior and teacher of martial arts
- Became one of the greatest military instructors in Hindu mythology

### 2. viśvāmitra's Journey

- Born as a kṣatriya (warrior class)
- Become a Brahmarishi (sage of highest order)
- Through intense spiritual practice, achieved his goal
- Exemplifies the power of personal determination over birth circumstances

## Philosophical Synthesis

The scriptures recognize that while jāti provides structure and stability, individual guṇas and personal choice play crucial roles in determining one's path. Both approaches—honoring tradition and following personal inclination—are respected and supported within the philosophical framework.

- Career choices are increasingly diverse and fluid
